Threading text blocks

- All text in PageMaker resides inside containers called **text blocks**.
- A Text block can be connected to other text block so that the text in one text block can flow into another text block.
- Text blocks that are connected in this way are **threaded**.
- The process of connecting text among Text blocks is called **threading text**.
- Text that flows through one or more threaded blocks is called a **story**.

Threading text blocks

- A threaded text block can be identified by a plus sign in its top and/or bottom handles.
- Unthreaded text is where a text block stands alone, without being connected to any other block.

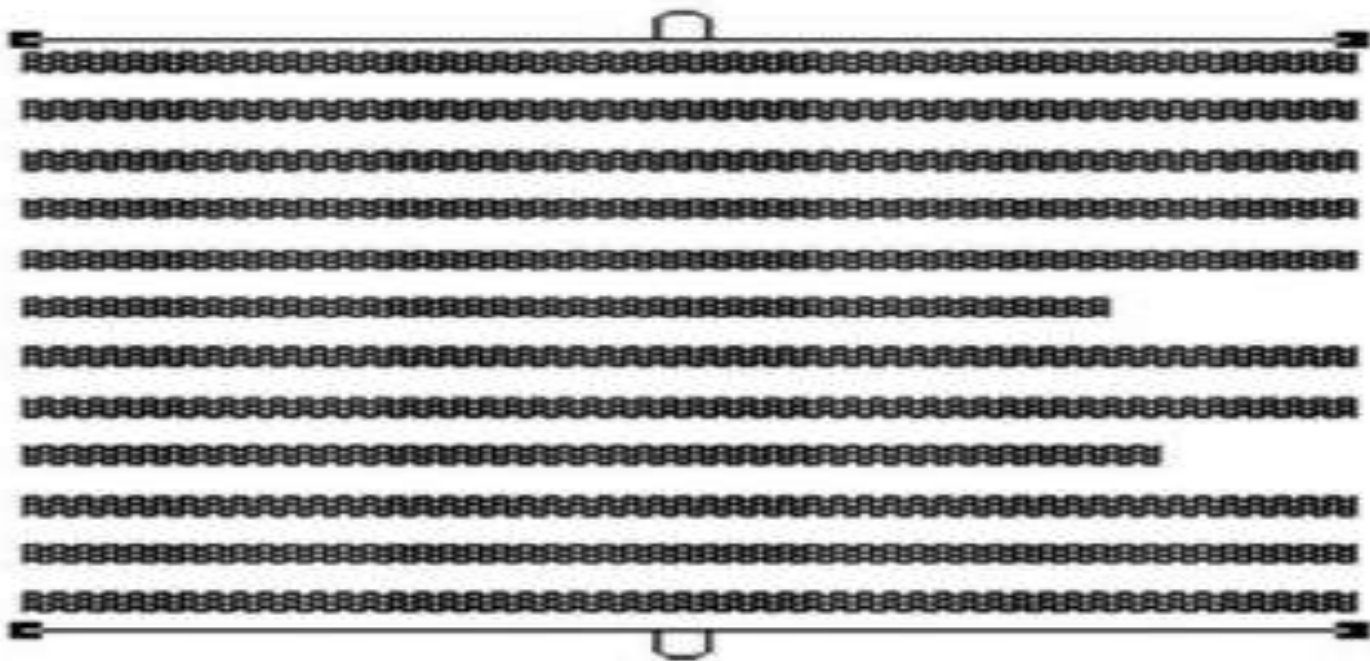
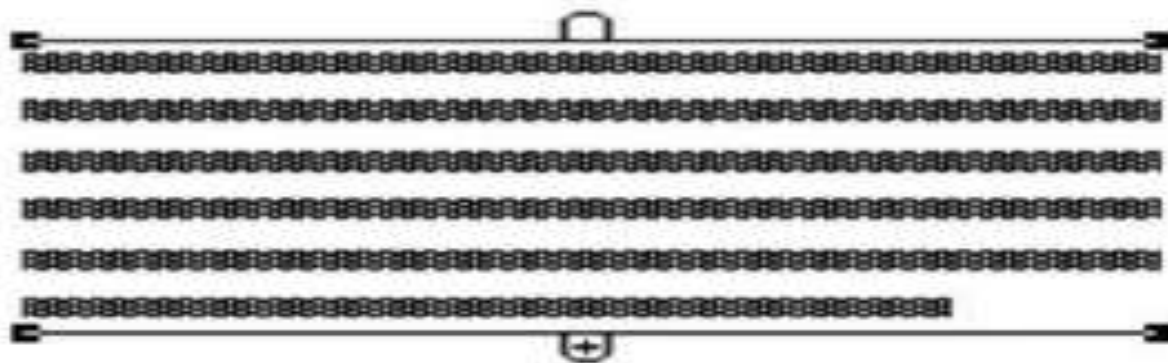


Figure 2.23 Unthreaded text



To unthread a threaded block

- Select the block that you wish to unthread with the pointer tool.
- Click on Edit > Cut in the menu bar.(the block disappear).
- Now click on the Edit > Paste in the menu bar.
- The block will reappear in the same position, but it is now an unthreaded block.

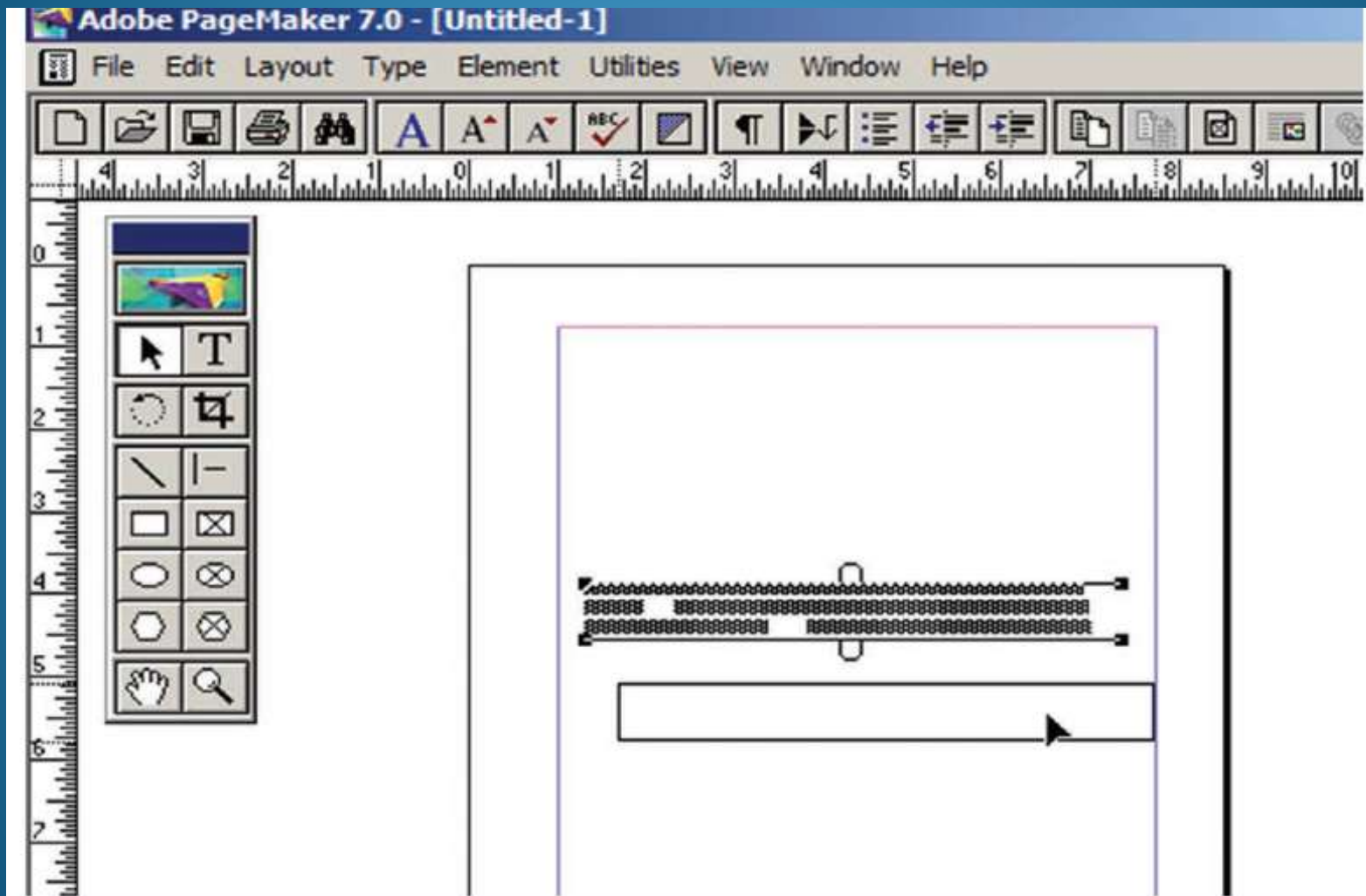


Figure 2.12 Moving a text block

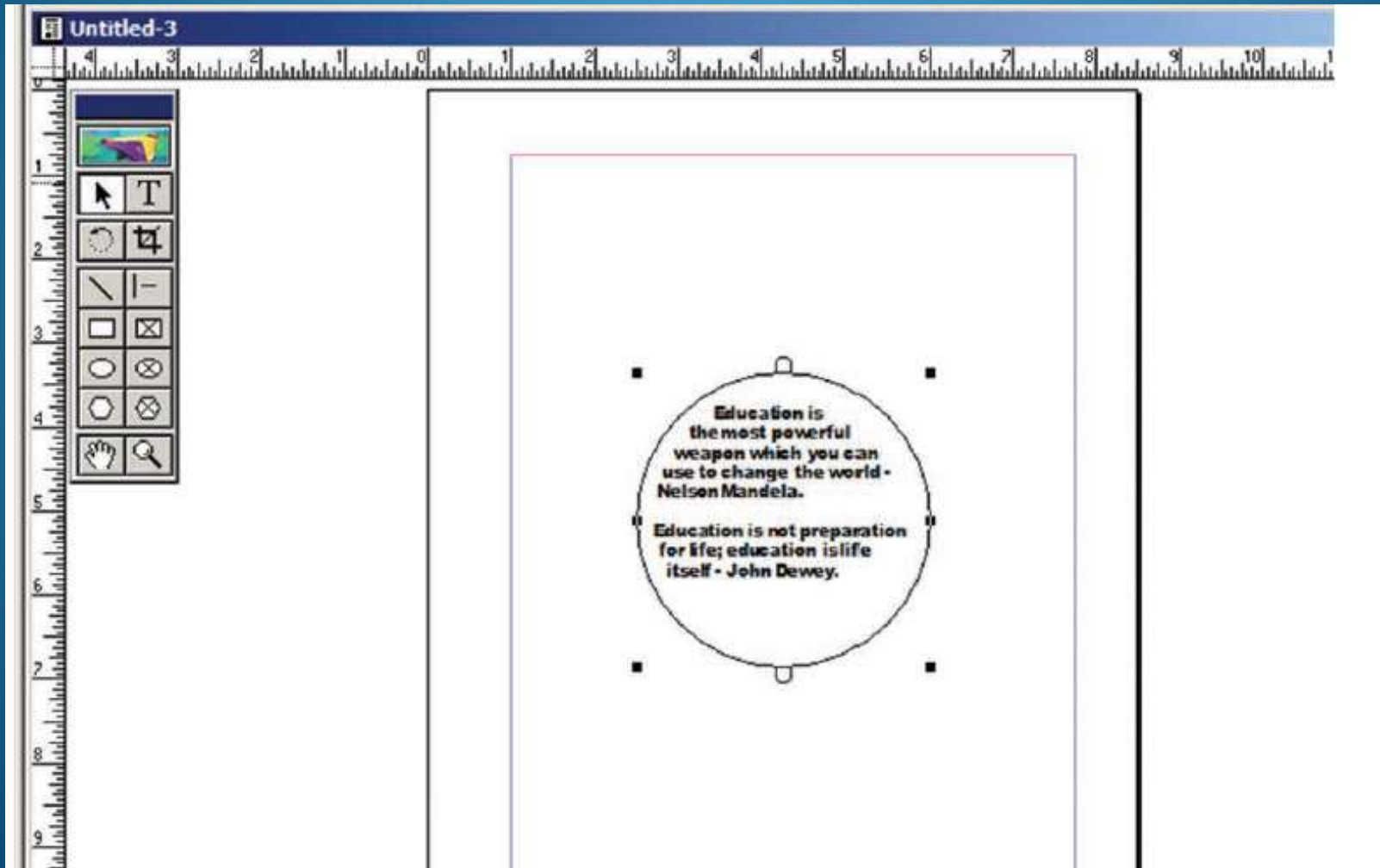
Placing Text in a Frame

- Click on any one Frame tool from the Toolbox.
- Draw a frame with one of PageMaker's Frame tools (Rectangle frame tool or Ellipse Frame Tool or Polygon frame Tool).
- Click on **File > Place**. The Place dialog box will appears.

Placing Text in a Frame

- Locate the document that contains the text you want to place, select it.
- Click on **Open**.
- Click inside the frame to place the text in it.

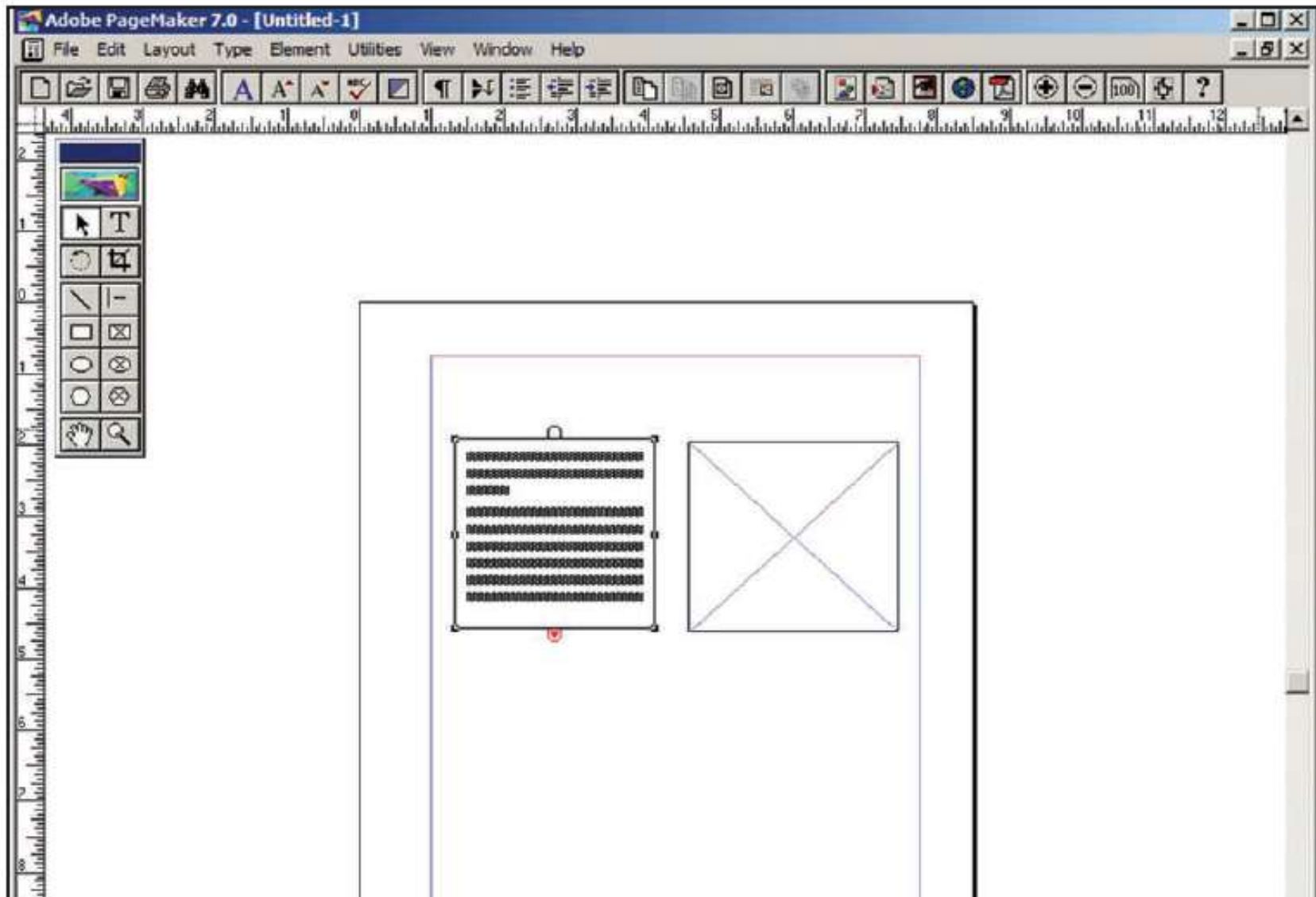
Placing Text in a Frame



Linking Frames containing Text

- Draw a **second frame** with the **Frame tool** of your choice.
- Click the **first frame** to select it.
- Click on the **red triangle** to load the **text icon**.
- Click the **second frame**. PageMaker flows the text into the **second frame**.
- Drag the windowshade handle down to show more text.
